

New mini-mall Downtown

The former Hughes & Hatcher men's store, Wood Street and Oliver Avenue, Downtown, is being converted into a mini-mall scheduled to open Feb. 1, 1984. The \$200,000 conversion has already begun. Potential tenants are Computer Workshop; a sales and service training company located in Monroeville; and two men's clothing stores — the Coach House and Joseph Banks. According to Rod Callahan, property manager of First Union Management Inc., prospective tenants are expected to sign leases by Sept. 30. The 27,000-square-foot former men's store occupies part of two floors and the basement of the 300 Sixth Ave. Building. Burt Hill Kosar Rittelmann Associates are designing the mini-mall. The contractor is Shannon Construction Co.
