SCAFFOLDING DOs & DON'Ts

Falls are the leading cause of death in the construction industry



DO

- Inspect the scaffold before each use
- Use all components correctly per manufacturer instructions
- Wear required PPE (hard hats, non-skid boots, tool lanyards)
- Lock wheels before climbing or working
- Keep the platform clean and free of debris or tripping hazards
- Use netting or debris protection to catch falling objects
- Level the scaffold each time it's moved
- Maintain an emergency and rescue plan

DON'T

- Don't overload beyond the scaffold's rated capacity
- Don't use damaged, incomplete, or missing parts
- Don't climb cross-braces or guardrails instead of proper access
- Don't move the scaffold with people on it unless designed for it and conditions allow
- Don't use boxes, ladders, or barrels inside the scaffold to raise working height
- Don't work on planks covered with ice, snow, mud, or slick substances
- Don't ignore electrical hazards: stay clear of power lines
